Shippable product – The core focus of Agile Product Management is to regularly create and release working software which the stakeholders or customers can test or use. Scrum is a framework designed to make team collaboration on complex products as effective as possible. The product owner manages the product's backlog, a collection of tasks that need to be completed to deliver the product. The self-organizing development team then works through these tasks during a period of time known as a sprint.
