All applicants for licensure as a PE in California are required to first pass the FE exam and obtain the EIT certificate unless you meet the criteria for waiving the FE exam under Board Rule 438 <http://www.bpelsg.ca.gov/laws/boardrules.pdf> This applies to all PE licenses including Traffic Engineer.
