An acid is a substance that reacts with water to produce hydronium ions, H3O+. A base is a substance that produces hydroxide ions, OH-, in water. CHEM 0012 Lecture Notes 3. When an acid and base reacts, an ionic compound is produced as one of the products. We call ionic compounds "salts".

Acids, Bases and Salts

Salts . When acid and base neutralize, salts are formed. Strong acid and strong base combines to form neutral salt. NaOH + HCl → NaCl + H 2 O. Eq.1. Formation of Neutral Salt. Strong acid and weak base combine to form acidic salt. For Example, Hydrochloric Acid and ammonium hydroxide combine to form ammonium chloride. Other examples, sodium hydrogen carbonate, sodium hydrogen sulphate etc.
