The Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) requires a fee of \$20 for each inquiry of an individual's child abuse and neglect findings request. If submitting multiple requests, one check may be sent for the total cost. Forms must be typed, not handwritten, dated and signed.

Neglect. Child neglect is failure to provide adequate food, shelter, affection, supervision, education, or dental or medical care. In many cases, child abuse is done by someone the child knows and trusts — often a parent or other relative. If you suspect child abuse, report the abuse to the proper authorities.

Child abuse and neglect is, at a minimum, any recent act or failure to act on the part of a parent or caretaker, which results in death, serious physical or emotional harm, sexual abuse or exploitation (including sexual abuse as determined under section 111), or an act or failure to act which presents an imminent risk of serious harm (Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act).
