Community Care Center is: NOT a walk-in clinic. We see patients by appointment only. Staffed primarily by volunteers who give their time without compensation. Supported by contributions from individuals, churches, businesses, foundation grants, United Way, and patient donations. Community Care Center. Does NOT provide emergency care.

Becoming a Patient at the Community Care Center

Governed by a community board composed of a majority (51% or more) of health center patients who represent the population served. Provide comprehensive primary health care services as well as supportive services (education, translation and transportation, etc.) that promote access to health care.
