Now let's move on to creating your own formulas. The first step to creating a formula is to type an equal sign into the cell where you will be placing it. Now you are ready to begin the input of your actual formula. If we wanted to divide 6 by 3, we would input the following:

To start the formula, type = and then select cell A2. Type * (Shift+8 on the top row of the keyboard). The asterisk is used for multiplication rather than the x symbol you used in school. Select cell B2 in the worksheet with the mouse, keyboard, or by tapping it on the screen (when using a touchscreen device).

Enter an opening bracket ([), and then select the [ProductSubcategory] column to finish the formula.
