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Double Replacement Reactions Laboratory Manual

When a double replacement reaction occurs, the cations and anions switch partners, resulting in the formation of water and a new ionic compound (or salt), which is usually soluble. Neutralization reactions are exothermic, and are generally accompanied by a noticeable release of heat. Example 2: sulfuric acid + aqueous lithium hydroxide

Double Replacement Reactions A double replacement reaction has the form: $AB + CD \rightarrow AD + CB$ There are four different possible outcomes to a reaction such as this: [1] Formation of a gas. There are certain compounds which are unstable and decompose to water and a gas. Three common ones are H_2CO_3 , H_2SO_3 and NH_4OH . They decompose like this: $H_2CO_3 \rightarrow H_2O + CO_2$

Double Replacement – A reaction where the elements from two compounds replace one another. (Partners switch). $AB + CD \rightarrow AD + CB$. $AgNO_3(aq) + NaCl(aq) \rightarrow AgCl(s) + NaNO_3(aq)$ $HCl(aq) + NaOH(aq) \rightarrow NaCl(aq) + H_2O(l)$ In today's experiment you will deal primarily with decomposition, single replacement and double replacement reactions.

Double Replacement Reactions All double replacement reactions have the general form: $AB + CD \rightarrow AD + CB$ Reactions that can be classified as double replacements include precipitation reactions, neutralization reactions and gas forming reactions.

Double-Replacement Reactions. A double-replacement reaction is a reaction in which the positive and negative ions of two ionic compounds exchange places to form two new compounds. The general form of a double-replacement (also called double-displacement) reaction is: (11.9.1) $AB + CD \rightarrow AD + BC$. In this reaction, A and C are positively-charged cations, while B and D are negatively-charged anions.

If there are more reactants than products, it is a synthesis reaction. If oxygen is a part of the reactant, it is a combustion reaction. If one ion replaces another, it is a single replacement reaction. If there are two compounds in a reactant where cations switch, it is a double replacement reaction.
