A process evaluation focuses on the implementation process and attempts to determine how successfully the project followed the strategy laid out in the logic model. As opposed to outcome or impact evaluations, a process evaluation focuses on the first three segments of the logic model (inputs, activities, and outputs) and how they work together. Process evaluations allow evaluators to make the important distinction between implementation failure and theory failure.
