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Food Fraud Vulnerability Assessment And

A food fraud vulnerability assessment is much like a conventional risk assessment, which is based on the likelihood of a risk occurring versus the consequences. In a vulnerability assessment for food fraud, the likelihood of food fraud occurring and the consequences if the food fraud was to occur are plotted onto a risk matrix to obtain the overall vulnerability.

FSIS conducts vulnerability assessments to better prevent and protect against an intentional attack on its regulated products. Based on the assessments, FSIS develops countermeasures to protect the food supply as directed by Homeland Security Presidential Directive-9(HSPD-9).

There are other specific tools or models available, including the U.S. Pharmacopeia adulterant-substance vulnerability assessment focused on food ingredients and others addressing all food fraud types such as cargo theft.

- Vulnerability assessment (or vulnerability characterisation): Within a food fraud management system, the step aimed at reviewing and assessing various factors, which create vulnerabilities in a supply chain (i.e. weak points where fraud has greater chances to occur).

As part of the food fraud plan (refer to 2.7.2.1 and 2.7.2.2) the site shall include within the vulnerability assessment and mitigation plan the potential risks for economic adulteration that may impact food safety for all incoming materials. Vulnerabilities may include ingredient substitution, mislabeling, dilution or counterfeiting.
