Symptomatic plasma cell myeloma diagnosis requires: 1) Bone marrow infiltrate of clonal plasma cells (usually >10% of nucleated cells on bone marrow biopsy although no minimum percentage is designated in WHO diagnostic criteria) or the presence of a proven plasmacytoma.

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
