Programs using the guidelines (or percentage multiples of the guidelines — for instance, 125 percent or 185 percent of the guidelines) in determining eligibility include Head Start, the Food Stamp Program, the National School Lunch Program, the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program, and the Children’s Health Insurance Program.

In order to qualify for Healthy Families, the parenting or pregnant teen must show proof of income. Her income can be no less than \$1,750 per month and no greater than \$2,900 per month for one child. As the number of children rises, the monthly income rises as well. Those making less than \$1,750 per month gross can apply for Medi-Cal instead.

Healthy Families California Program Qualifications Residents must meet income requirements to get insurance through Covered California. That guideline ranges from 0 to 400 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, with your percentage of that poverty level determining what you pay in premiums.

DC Healthy Families is a program that provides free health insurance to DC residents who meet certain income and U.S. citizenship or eligible immigration status to qualify for DC Medicaid. The DC Healthy Families program covers doctor visits, vision and dental care, prescription drugs, hospital stays, and transportation for appointments.

Persons may be eligible for the Healthy Families Program dental plan if they meet the following conditions: The child is under 19 years old; The child is a California resident; The family’s total income falls within the income guidelines; The child has not been covered under the parent’s employer-sponsored health insurance in the last 3 months

Healthy Families

MCAP is for middle-income families who do not have health insurance and whose income is too high for no-cost Medi-Cal. MCAP is also available to women who have other health insurance plans that doesn't cover maternity services or with a maternity-only deductible or copayment greater than \$500.

Children who are in families with an income ranging from 150% to 200% of the FPL must not have any insurance coverage to be qualified for the Healthy Start program. Those who do have other health insurance may still be eligible if the income of the family is below 150% of the FPL.

FAMILIES Many times, the entire family may be eligible for health care benefits: Low Income Families (LIF) Medicaid is available to families under the Low Income Family (LIF) Program. There are income and asset tests. Families that receive cash assistance (Family Independence Program or FIP) are automatically eligible for this program.
