In all 5.1 channel systems, '5' represent the number of speakers and '.1' represent the sixth channel also called low-frequency effect (LFE) channel. These 5 speakers include two front speakers, two surround speakers, and one front center speaker. As a low-frequency channel, a subwoofer is added to the system.

You'll place three speakers and the woofer toward the front of the room, and the two remaining speakers on either side and slightly behind your viewing position. Keep speakers at least 20 inches from walls.
