The letters were written by Clara in May and June 1851 from Dusseldorf, Germany, where the Schumann's were then living. Clara was 31 years old at the time, with five children and another on the way, and an active performing and teaching career. Robert's mental illness had not yet surfaced and he was actively composing and conducting.
