RESULTS: In the follow-up period, 75 of the 146 patients in the case management group (51.4 percent) and 51 of the 143 patients in the control group (35.7 percent) were rehospitalized for psychiatric care. On average, patients spent 31.1 days in city hospitals and 26.6 days in state hospitals.
