Let's begin by looking at the most common gospel chord progression: the 2-5-1 progression. This will come up often in gospel and jazz genres of music. In the key of C, you'd play Dm7-G7-C. In gospel music, the 2-5-1 works to beautifully transition you to a different chord in the progression you're playing.

You will want to add 7ths as well as extended chords such as 9ths and 11ths. Gospel music is very expressive to match the enthusiasm of the preacher and the congregation. Common gospel progressions include the 7-3-6-2-5-1 progression, the 3-6-2-5-1 progression and the 6-2-5-1 progression. Extend your chords to give them a more fluid and funky sound. An extended chord is just a variation or enhancement of the basic chords with additional notes.

Gospel Piano Chords - Black Gospel Chords

This is called a "cadential" chord progression in music theory, and it's particularly common in classical, church, and gospel settings. The ii-V-I chord progression is complete on its own, but it can also be made into the longer progression I-vi-ii-V-I.

We used it in Gospel progression Part 1. It's the A diminished 7th chord and again, we're playing it with the root and diminished 7th in the left hand and that stack of minor 3rds in the right. We're using the same V chord voicing in our Part 2 Gospel progression. It's the IV chord over the V chord which is structurally an 11th chord.

Gospel Progression 2 | Altered Chords

There's common progressions in gospel music that correspond with the numeric scale/ chord degrees. For example: 7_3_6. 5_1_4. 3_6_2. 2_5_1. Longer progressions are a mix between the above shorter progressions.
