APPLIES TO: SQL Server 2016 Power BI Report Server. Reporting Services uses role-based security to grant user access to a report server. On a new report server installation, only users who are members of the local Administrators group have permissions to report server content and operations.

Grant user access to a report server - SQL Server ...

You have to add the Windows administrator group to the Sql sysadmins role. You can add the group like this: Open Sql Server Management Studio. Open Security -> Logins, and create a login for the Administrators group. Open Security -> Server Roles, and add the login to the syadmin role.

Administrator cannot administer sql server reporting services

Open Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio and run as "Administrator" Select Server type as Reporting Services and click OK

Make sure that the current account that will be used to manage SSRS permissions is a member of the Local Administrator Group on the SSRS Server. Login to the SSRS (SQL Server Reporting Service) Server. Open Server Manager > Tools > Computer Management. Local Users and Groups > Groups > Double click on Administrators group. Make sure that the SSRS account that will manage the SSRS is a member of this Local Administrator Group. If it does not exist, add it.

After opening up SSMS, change the server type to Reporting Services, enter your Server Name, and login information and then click Connect. After connecting to the Report Server, open the Security Folder, as noted in the following screen print.

To grant report administrator access in SSRS (SQL Server Reporting Services): Run Internet Explorer as Administrator. In Internet Explorer, go to your Report Manager URL. You can open the Microsoft Reporting Services Configuration Manager... Click Site Settings, and create a new role assignment so ...

Granting access in SSRS to reports

SQL Server Reporting Services is a server-based report generating software system made by Microsoft and used as a solution for companies who need to build custom reports from a variety of data sources, such as SQL databases and other external sources, that gives administrators the ability to share reports to users based on access permissions and user groups.

In the ReportServer database: In the Users table there should "BUILTIN\Administrators". In the Roles table there should "System Administrator", TaskMask = 110101011. In the PolicyUserRole table, there should be a row with the GUIDs from User and Role above.

Lost ability to be admin on SQL Server Reporting Services ...
