Using face-to-face interviews to evaluate more than 8,000 people according to the DSM-III-R criteria for substance abuse or dependence, the investigators found a lifetime prevalence of approximately 7.5 percent for drug abuse or dependence and of approximately 27 percent for any substance-use disorder in persons between 15 and 54 years of age (See Figure 1 below). Less than half of those with substance abuse or dependence had ever received any treatment for these conditions.

Recent findings from the NSDUH documented consistent rates of DSM-IV drug-use disorders (i.e. DSM-IV abuse or dependence on illicit drugs) over the past decade, varying little from 2002 (3.1%) to 2010 (2.8%) among those ages 12 or older (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, 2011). While the prevalence of abuse or dependence on illicit drugs in 2010 was higher among all males (3.6%) than females (2.0%) in the survey, the rate was higher for females (4.9%) than males (4.6 ...
