A partogram or partograph is a composite graphical record of key data during labour entered against time on a single sheet of paper. Relevant measurements might include statistics such as cervical dilation, fetal heart rate, duration of labour and vital signs. It is intended to provide an accurate record of the progress in labour, so that any delay or deviation from normal may be detected quickly and treated accordingly. Two trials conducted in Canada and Mexico involving a total of 1590 women compared partograph with no partograph.In one trial, there were no significant differences in the mean duration (MD) of the first (MD 0.8 hrs, 95% CI -0.06 to 1.66) or second (MD 0 hrs, 95% CI -0.21 to 0.21) stages of labour.

### WHO recommendation on the use of active phase partograph ...

The partograph is a graphic record of the progress of labour and relevant details of the mother and fetus. It was initially introduced as an early warning system to detect labour that was not progressing normally. This would allow for timely transfer to occur to a referral centre, for augmentation or Caesarean section as required.
